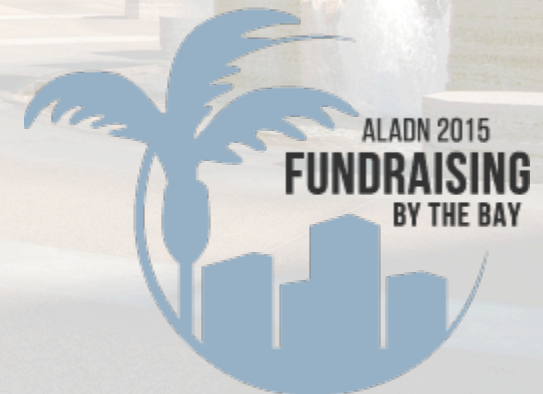

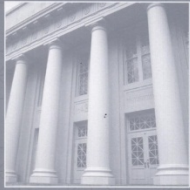

Since the end of that campaign in mid-2003, we have raised an additional \$56 million, bringing our total giving to \$270 million.

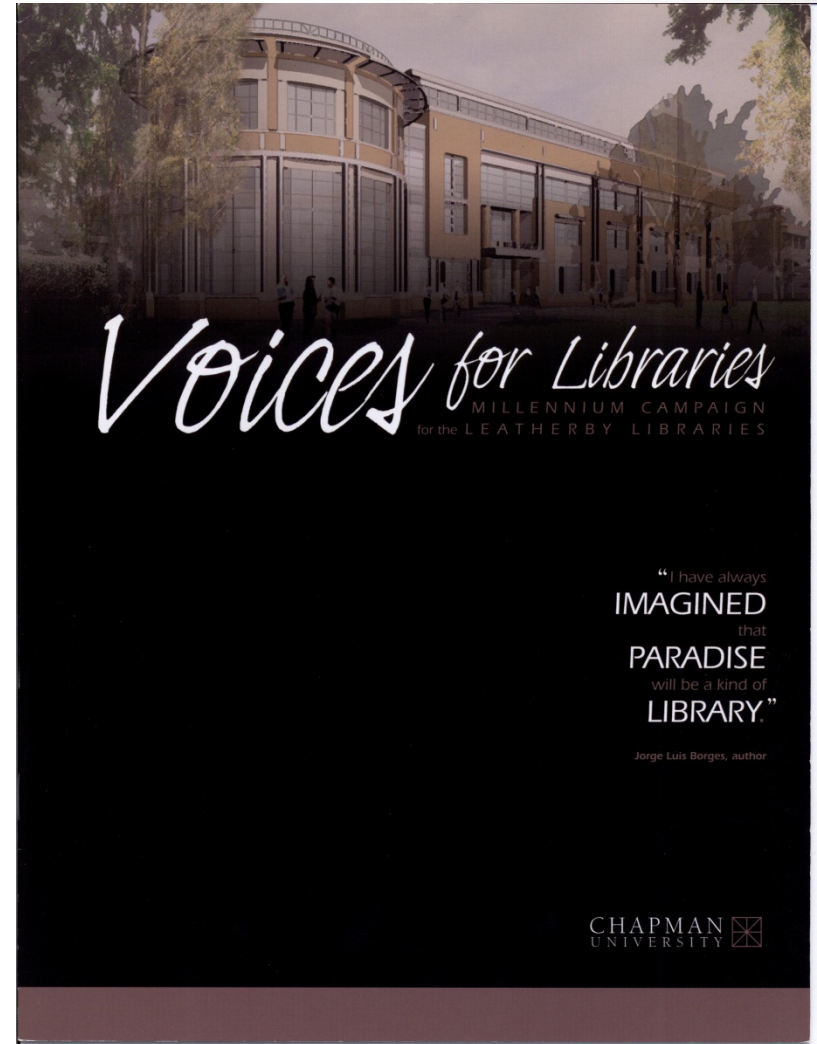

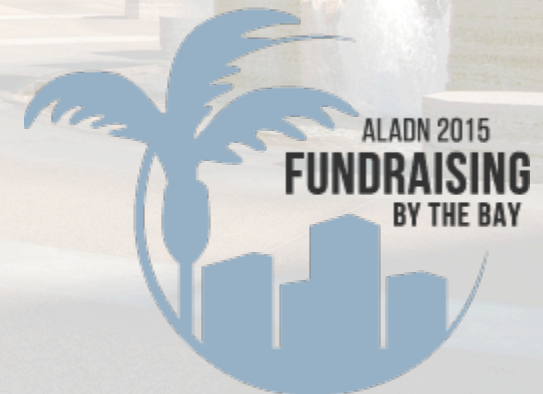
